



Cattle Clinic with Betty Wililams

Betty Williams is a well known stock dog handler, breeder, trainer and clinician. She and her husband John operate Sweeting Ranch, where they run about 250 head of Angus cattle and 300 head of Katahdin sheep on 4000 acres. Betty's dogs help them daily with ranch work from round-up and sorting to penning and loading for shipment. Betty has developed an efficient system for training stock dogs and handlers, which maximizes both the dog's working instincts and its responsiveness to the handler. She has found that her training methods work very well for all stock dog breeds. Betty has also been successful on the trial field, winning the ASCA Stockdog Finals in Cattle (1997, 2010), Sheep (2010), and Ducks (2001), as well as the ASCA National Specialty High Combined Stockdog in 1998 and 1999.

Bring a chair and weather appropriate clothing or shade if needed.
